 -  Rich and Harmonious, with powerful tannins and a long dry finish.
 -  50% Syrah, 25% Cabernet Sauvignon and 25 % Merlot.
 -  Aged one year in new French oak barrels.
 -  Good aging potential from 5 to 15 years.
- Goes extremely well with red meats.

 -  13,000 bottles produced with excellent aging potential.
